ORDER re: CASE MANAGEMENT

The Court has ordered the following after review of the case, including timely filed Case Management Statements, without a conference.

FURTHER CASE MANAGEMENT CONFERENCE

The Case Management Conference currently scheduled for 02/25/2011 is **VACATED** and continued to 05/13/2011 at 10:00 AM in Dept. 20.

OTHER ORDERS

A. The Court issued the following TCMO in advance of the 2/25/2010 conference:

1. By separate order the Court has approved the stipulation of the parties as to the form, content and dissemination program of and for the class notice and the selection of the notice administrator.
2. Unless there are other issues to address by way of case management on 2/25/2011 the Court is inclined to continue the conference as set forth herein for a further CMC following expiration of the opt out period.
3. A further joint narrative CMS shall be filed at least 5 court days before the continued CMC and shall address at least the following issues:
 - a. A report from the notice administrator as to the number of notices disseminated, the number of opt outs and any unresolved issues relating to the notice program;
 - b. An indication from the parties as to whether they have now agreed to proceed to mediation and, if so, the selection of a mediator and timetable for this purpose. The Court reiterates its' observation that this case is particularly deserving of proceeding to mediation now that class certification has been resolved. If the parties are in agreement to proceed to mediation, but someone cannot agree on a neutral, the Court will assist in selection.
 - c. An identification of any 'merits' related unresolved discovery issues and any contemplated discovery and non-discovery motion practice.
4. If the parties are in agreement that there are no other case management issues requiring attention on 2/25/2011 they shall so notify the court and this TCMO will be converted to a CMO. Otherwise they shall appear.

B. The parties communicated their agreement with the foregoing by email. Accordingly, the foregoing is the order of the Court.
