

1 I, Guy A. Bryant, declare that I am an attorney licensed to practice before all courts of the  
2 State of California, and am the attorney of record for Defendant OAKLAND PORT SERVICES  
3 CORP. d/b/a AB TRUCKING, a California Corporation, (collectively hereinafter referred to as  
4 "AB Trucking" or "Defendant") in the above-entitled action. If called to testify I could  
5 competently attest to the following from my personal knowledge:

6 1. On November 23, 2011, Bryant & Brown substituted into this case after prior legal  
7 counsel, Jay Aboudi, suffered a medical condition requiring his immediate exit from representing  
8 AB Trucking. Bryant & Brown had to prepare for a class action trial to begin on February 14,  
9 2012, where AB Trucking was accused of violating state overtime laws, meal & rest break laws,  
10 and local Oakland Living Wage ordinances.

11 2. The Court conducted a 10 day bench trial between February 14, 2012 and March 12,  
12 2012. Plaintiffs ultimately dismissed their overtime claims and the Court dismissed all claims  
13 regarding the Oakland Living Wage violations. Despite the vigorous efforts of Bryant & Brown  
14 to defend the interests of AB Trucking in this pending litigation, AB Trucking fell substantially  
15 behind in its agreed payments to Bryant & Brown for legal services provided beginning in the  
16 fall of 2012.

17 3. Attached to this declaration is a true and correct copy of the March 7, 2013, letter to Mr.  
18 William Aboudi notifying him of Bryant & Brown's termination of legal services to AB  
19 Trucking for failure to pay legal fees.

20 4. Attached to this declaration is a true and correct copy of the May 1, 2013, letter to Mr.  
21 William Aboudi alerting him of the consequences to a corporation for not having legal  
22 representation if Bryant & Brown were to withdraw from representing AB Trucking for non-  
23 payment of legal fees.

I am writing regarding the outstanding balance on your invoices for legal services for Oakland Maritime Support Services ("OMSS") and Oakland Port Services dba AB Trucking ("AB") which are in arrears in the amount of approximately \$[REDACTED] for OMSS and \$[REDACTED] for AB, respectively, for a period of more than sixty (60) days. Please bring your account current no later than March 15, 2013 to avoid withdrawal of legal services from this law office. Bryant & Brown is unable to continue to represent you and maintain the level of service that our clients expect without payment as set forth in the Agreement for Legal Services between this office and you.

Enclosed please find a copy of the December 28, 2012 invoice for legal services provided to OMSS reflecting the outstanding balance of \$[REDACTED], which remains past due in the amount of \$[REDACTED] as of this date. This office received a payment of \$[REDACTED] today which reduces the past due balance to \$[REDACTED]. Also enclosed is the invoice for legal services dated November 28, 2012 provided to AB reflecting the outstanding balance of \$[REDACTED] which remains past due in the amount of \$[REDACTED] at this time. As we have noted in prior correspondence, this office cannot continue to represent you, or carry any your past due balance, unless you make a substantial payment against your overdue balance.

Dear Bill:

Please accept this letter as notification that Oakland Maritime Support Services ("OMSS") and Oakland Port Services dba AB Trucking ("AB Trucking") may not appear without an attorney in a California state court and federal district court. Accordingly, OMSS must obtain new counsel to finalize the proposed settlement in the Northern California River Watch v. Oakland Maritime Support Services litigation. Failure to obtain representation could result in a forfeiture of the proposed settlement and inability to appear in the Case Management Conference scheduled for June 20, 2013 as well as other pre-trial hearings and the trial scheduled in this matter for March 14, 2014.

Likewise, AB Trucking must obtain new counsel if it wishes to pursue appeal of any post trial decision in the matter of Lavon Godfrey v. Oakland Port Services dba AB Trucking. Failure to obtain representation could result in a forfeiture of rights that may be available regarding appeal, if and when a decision is rendered in that matter.

As explained in my earlier correspondence of March 7, 2013 and April 25, 2013 and the correspondence of Guy Bryant dated April 22, 2013 notifying you of our intent to withdraw as counsel of record; we have not heard from you with regard to a strategy to pay for overdue invoices. Bryant & Brown is unable to represent you and maintain the level of service that our clients expect without payment as set forth in the Agreement for Legal Services between this office and you in these matters.
