**ORDER re: CASE MANAGEMENT**

The Court has ordered the following after review of the case, including timely filed Case Management Statements, without a conference.

**FURTHER CASE MANAGEMENT CONFERENCE**

The Case Management Conference currently scheduled for 10/07/2010 is **VACATED** and continued to 12/03/2010 at 10:00 AM in Dept. 20.

**OTHER ORDERS**

1. The CMC is continued without an appearance on 10/7/2010 to await filing of defendants' answer to current operative amended complaint. Plaintiffs shall file their revised motion for class certification no later than 11/22/2010 and normal briefing schedules shall be followed for the opposition/reply unless the parties jointly propose an modified briefing and hearing schedule.
2. If the parties are unable to agree on a modified briefing schedule, the party requesting departure from the code specified time periods shall apply by ex-parte application to the Court for any such modification.
3. Plaintiffs are reminded of the necessity of obtaining a reservation number/hearing date from the Court.
4. To the extent the parties rely on declarations or other material filed in support of, opposition, or reply to opposition of the previous class certification motion, they may incorporate such materials by reference in connection with the contemplated renewed motion. However, each side must provide 'hard copy' courtesy copies of all such material to Dept. 20 along with courtesy copies of any new filings.
5. If the revised class certification motion is set for hearing substantially in advance of the 12/3/2010 continued CMC date, the CMC will be advanced to coincide with hearing the motion. No updated statements are required but the parties should be prepared to address case management to follow the determination of revised certification motion.
